

THE ROLE OF A BUSINESS COACH/ MENTOR

We thank you for your interest in becoming a Coach/Mentor. Below we have outlined the qualifications we believe are needed for our program:

Qualifications:

- Experience in writing or evaluating Feasibility/ Business Plans.
- Experience in working with the defined target population.
- Experience as a business owner, adult education instructor, or affiliation with a Small Business Development Center.

Preparation:

- Participates in Facilitation Team meetings prior to each session, as called by the Facilitator.
- Reviews assigned readings prior to each session.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Attends all FastTrac sessions (10 sessions total).
- Keeps Facilitation Team informed of progress and any special needs of assigned participants.
- Reviews and critiques completed take-home assignments each week.
- Evaluates completed sections of Feasibility Plans at regularly scheduled intervals.
- Reviews business licensing requirements with each assigned participant for their particular business.
- Follows up with assigned participants at the end of the program for completed Feasibility Plans. Critiques and evaluates Feasibility Plans.
- Assists guest speakers by keeping participants on task, formulating questions, and helping with the transition to and from presentations.
