The Job-Link center helps people with employment, skills training, and family strengthening. Trained employment consultants can assist with resume preparation, interviewing skills, and access to online employment opportunities. The Job-Link center also provides computer access so that our clients can look for a job and submit online resumes and job applications. Finally, the Job-Link center provides referrals to family strengthening services within the community. In addition, we partner with numerous agencies across Southwest Florida with the common goal of helping individuals become more independent.

LCS Food Pantry

LCS Choice pantry is open Monday, Wednesday, & Friday from 9-11:30 a.m. Must be a resident of Lehigh Acres, FL and documentation is required.

Emergency Utility Assistance

LCS offers limited financial assistance, if an individual qualifies, once a year. Funds are available with a 3 time lifetime limit. Must be a resident of Lehigh Acres, FL and documentation is required. In addition, a budget class is mandatory to receive financial assistance.

Literacy Volunteers of Lehigh

Volunteer tutors teach English to those of different cultures and nationalities as well as persons unable to read and write. In addition, classes are offered to assist individuals in preparation for the United States Citizenship Test.

Unemployment

Application assistance is provided to those who wish to file an unemployment compensation claim, as well as those who wish to input their job search data and claim weeks.

Voucher Program
