The Beacon of H.O.P.E., originally organized to respond to the destruction of Hurricane Charlie, has grown into a Pine Island community assistance organization that identifies and responds to the needs of our neighbors. Our current community programs, in addition to the offerings of the Pine Island Attic, include:

Off-island Programs locally accessed through the Beacon

Meals On Wheels deliveries - The Beacon is the exclusive P.I. distributor of MOWs from the Community Cooperative Ministries of Fort Myers

ACCESS Point (DCF) - Medicaid, Food Stamps, Cash Assistance, Unemployment

AARP - Jobs for Low Income Seniors

Elder Care - Rent, Utilities, prescriptions for the elderly

Vocational Rehab - Employment Training/Assistance for the Disabled

Lee County Human Resources (LIHEAP) - We are the P.I. out-reach site for energy payments to low income households
