

Job-Link and Family Strengthening Centers (United Way Houses)

Located in five counties (Lee, Hendry, Glades, Collier and Charlotte) Goodwill's Job-Link centers (16 in five counties-Pine Manor added in 2013) help people with employment, skills training, and family strengthening. Goodwill is a strong advocate of the United Way House model and the benefit that this “one stop” service model provides to the community. This service model promotes community non-profit collaboration, efficiency and a seamless delivery system. In addition to being the lead agency of six (6) United Way Houses (Suncoast Estates, Bonita Springs; Palm Beach; Clewiston; Moore Haven; and Pine Manor), we are active partners in seven (7) other United Way Houses including Beacon of Hope on Pine Island, Triage, Cape Coral, Lehigh Community Services, Labelle, Harlem Heights, and Dunbar. Our trained employment consultants can assist with resume preparation, interviewing skills, and access to online employment opportunities. Job-Link centers, located across Southwest Florida, also provide computer access so that our clients can look for a job and submit online resumes and job applications. Many of our computers are equipped with adaptive technology to assist people with disabilities. Finally, Job-Link centers provide referrals to family strengthening services in the community.

- Job-Link Centers provide clients with the tools they need to find prepare for employment, locate employment opportunities, and access essential social services and resources to attain self-sufficiency and independence. This includes, assistance with **resume preparation, interviewing skills, assistance with ACCESS (benefits), linkage to community resources, access to online employment opportunities and employment services, and access to unemployment benefits online.**
- We provide computer access so that our clients can look for a job and submit online resumes and job applications. Many of our computers are equipped with adaptive technology to assist people with disabilities. Our adaptive technology is comprised of Screen Magnifiers, Visually Impaired Workstations, Adesso iMouse T1 ergonomic Optical Trackball Scroll Mouse, Dragon Naturally Speaking Software, Low Vision Keyboard B/W, and Ergonomic Keyboard and braille keyboards.
- Job-Link centers provide **referrals to Family Strengthening Services** in the community. We partner with numerous agencies across Southwest Florida with the common goal of helping people become more independent to provide the following services:
 - Money management
 - Housing and rental assistance
 - Adaptive medical equipment loan program
 - English as a second language courses
 - Income tax preparation
 - Effective parenting courses
 - Nutrition education
 - Housing counseling
 - Mental health services
 - Addiction and dependency services

 - Medicaid and health insurance for children
 - ACCESS Florida
 - Discounted/free cell phone
 - Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) in Hendry County
 - Community Services Block Grant (Agriculture and Labor Inc.)-Case Management in Hendry County

2014 OUTCOMES for Annual Report

Total Number of Unduplicated or persons served one time in 2014: 39,630 unduplicated (or those accessing our services for the first time this year) were served in 2014. Compared to 2013, in which there were **37,218** individuals served, there is an *increase of 2,412* new or unduplicated individuals that accessed services or an *increase of 6%*.

Total Number of Duplicated or Services Provided: There were 114,398 return or duplicated individuals served or services provided (or those returning for services) as of 12/31/14 and **81,321 in 2013** or an *increase of 33,077* served or a *41% increase*.

Compared to 2013, **there is increase of 38 job placements or self-employment outcomes or an increase of 6%** for a total of **671 in 2013** and **709 in 2014**.

As of December 31, 2014, **one (1) out of every seventeen (17) new individuals served secured a job** (588 Job Links which includes Admin; Mobile and Haitian Outreach; 3 Unfunded Services; 34 Employment Services and 13 HS/HT for a **total of 638 employed**). **Note: In 2013, 1 out of every 13 new clients served secured a job**.

Information and Referral Services: 9,098

Neighborhood Outreach: 16,348 new or unduplicated served (11,606 in 2013) and **82,371 return or duplicated persons served or service contacts conducted** (54,340 in 2013)

Job Link Services: As of December 31, 2014 we have provided assistance to **10,522 new clients** (*includes LIHEAP, Haitian Outreach, Mobile and Admin services*) at our Job-Link and Family Strengthening Centers (13 of 16 sites are United Way Houses), which compared to 2013 year to date, is an increase of **2,391 new individuals served or an increase of 29%** (8,131 served in 2013).

Community Work Experience: 1,578 in 2014 and 826 in 2013 or an increase of 91%.

Job Placements and Businesses Started or Sustained in 2014: (Job Link sites; Employment Services; High School/High Tech and MicroEnterprise Institute):

- **588 were placed in employment situations** through our collective **Job-Link Centers or an increase of 9% compared to 2013**. (This is a comparative increase of 47 placements as opposed to the outcomes as of December 31, 2013 in which 541 were placed within Job-Link Centers).
- **50 were placed through the Employment Services/Supported Employment Services, T.O.P. (OJT), Unfunded services, and the HS/HT Programs** (25 through Employment Services, 9 OJT, 3 Unfunded, and 13 in HS/HT placement) **or a decrease of 52 placements, or -51%** compared to 2013 in which **102 were placed**).
- **71 new and/or sustained, operational businesses (self-employment) were created through the MicroEnterprise Institute** which compared to 2013 is an increase of **154%** or an additional **43 businesses** (28 in 2013).

Clothing Vouchers and Bus Passes: 320 Vouchers (clothing, household materials) and 14 Bus Passes

Youth Services (HS/HT and LIFE ACADEMY): 176 HS/HT students enrolled with 34 graduates and 51 L.I.F.E Academy students enrolled with 4 student graduates

Employment Services (Division of Vocational Rehabilitation contracted services and On the Job Training-TOP):

- a. Employment Services (DVR contract) in 2014, there were 148 individuals with disabilities trained and 28 were employed.**
- b. OJT/On The Job Training: 19 individuals that graduated from the program with 9 individual placed externally.**

MicoEnterprise Institute (6 week, 12 module course for aspiring entrepreneurs): 117 Graduates and 71 new and/or sustained, operational businesses (self-employment) were created through the MicroEnterprise Institute which compared to 2013 is an increase of 154% or an additional 43 businesses (28 in 2013).

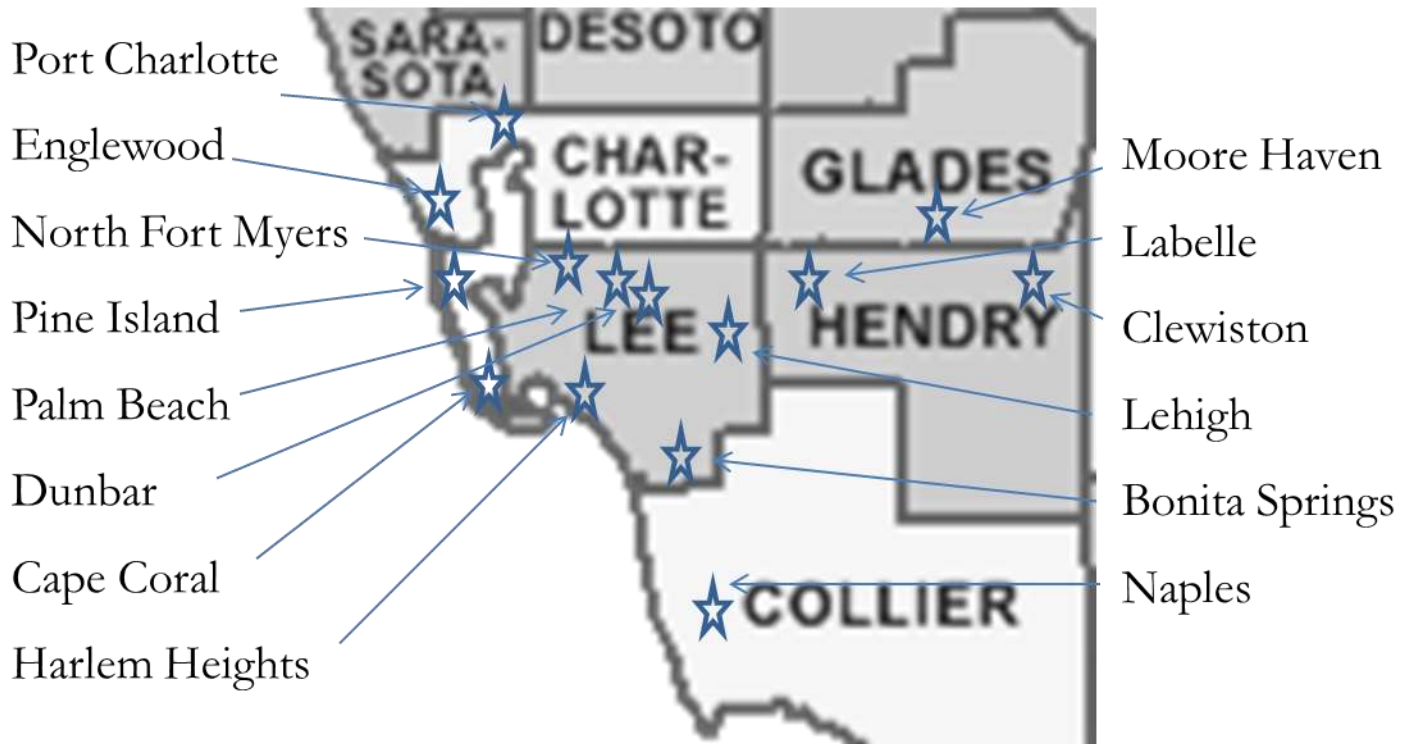

Several of our Centers are co-located with other service providers to enhance client linkage, coordination and the overall customer or client experience. Addresses are as follows:
