Goodwill SWFL receives SHIP funds for housing

The Lee County Board of Commission has approved the allocation of SHIP Funding (State Housing Initiative Partnership program) to make necessary upgrades and renovations to two of Goodwill Housing apartment complexes, The Pines in North Fort Myers and Country Cove in Lehigh Acres. The funding totaling more \$600,00 for these two projects will be used to renovate a total of 28 apartments for people with physical disabilities.

Goodwill Industries of SWFL has been providing housing for people with physical disabilities and income sensitive seniors for more than 23 years.
