Saying Goodbye after 46 Years



Opportunity Accelerator addresses skills gaps in the community by providing essential training to individuals who lack access to higher education paid training opportunities.



Goodwill Community Resource Center coordinators guide job seekers and career advancers through three phases: assess and plan, equip and connect, and launch and evaluate.

Hemstreet expressed gratitude for PNC Foundation, emphasizing the impact of this funding as "foundational in supporting the growth of workforce skills in our community."

"Through this grant, PNC has recognized Goodwill's efforts to empower individuals through education, career training and work, which contributes to generational change," said Hemstreet.

Goodwill Community Resource Job Fair Success Story | Allegiant Air

Earlier this year, Allegiant teamed up with Goodwill Industries of Southwest Florida (SWFL) to host a hiring fair to support the airline's operations at Punta Gorda Airport (PGD). Goodwill SWFL hosted the event at the Charlotte County Community Resource Center in Port Charlotte.

The airline recruited ground operations agents, customer service agents, passenger assistance agents, aircraft cleaners, and other roles as part of their strategy to meet increased demand for air travel in Southwest Florida.

The Goodwill Job Fair was a great success, as it helped Allegiant hire people to fill open part-time positions at PGD ahead of the airline's busy flying seasons.

Goodwill SWFL provides additional services, such as soft skills workshops, to support professional career advancement.


ACCESS Training


