

Free Nutrition Workshops

Goodwill and the Harry Chapin Food Bank are offering a six-week nutrition





workshop series at the Goodwill Opportunity Center. This class teaches participants how to prepare healthy meals without spending a lot.



Yolanda Bonita Springs, FL

Yolanda came to Goodwill for the first time unemployed, with language barriers, and with no transportation.

Her father is a client of a Goodwill Community Resource Center (CRC), and visits when he needs interpretation services or digital support. When Yolanda arrived from Mexico, he brought her to the CRC so that she could get help. The Goodwill Career Navigator provided Opportunity Accelerator orientation, resume assistance, job search and job application guidance. She even provided a mock interview to help her practice for the real thing.

Staff also explained that if she qualifies for the Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP), she can obtain low-cost home internet.

Additionally, the coordinator gave Yolanda information about the English Basic Level class and about ULTRA transportation.

Since coming to Goodwill, Yolanda has a job and has started ESL Basic Level Class at her local Goodwill CRC. She is happy that she received the assistance and has started working.

"We know she will achieve her goals because she is eager to learn. We feel happy to see that the work we do to help this family has been successful," says Yolanda's CRC coordinator.
