## **Connecting Employers with Job Seekers**

Our Lehigh Community Resource Center (CRC) held a registration and interview event with Rob Allen from Building Talent Foundation of JobsToBuild.com.

JobsToBuild is the residential construction jobs platform bringing employment and career opportunities to job seekers, and talented job candidates to employers across building trades.

# Goodwill receives \$10K from The Community Foundation of Sarasota County

The Community Foundation of Sarasota County has awarded a \$10,000 grant to Goodwill Industries of Southwest Florida, Inc. to support a customer service portal and kiosk in multiple languages which will allow Goodwill resource staff to better collect data, serve clients and track outcomes per specific demographic groups served.

As a pilot, this kiosk feature will be available at the Goodwill Community Resource Center (CRC) in Port Charlotte, allowing individuals to access assistance and overcome language barriers, while enabling Goodwill staff to more readily follow up with those served keeping them moving toward their goals.

## Port Charlotte Goodwill Community Resource Success Story | Ivette Muniz

Ivette Muniz came into the Goodwill Community Resource Center (CRC) to see if she could get help finding a job. Ivette had trouble keeping a job, and was experiencing difficulties with housing, finances and her family situation. The Goodwill CRC staff helped Ivette build a strong resume. Then, they helped her set up an online job search profile which allows candidates to apply for jobs easily. She also got some employability coaching, help applying for the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program, housing assistance, and help getting in-home internet connectivity.

With digital support from the Goodwill CRC Coordinator, Ivette received job offers and accepted a part-time dishwasher position at a local restaurant. This was work she had done before and really didn't want to continue that type of work, but she was encouraged to take the job to have something she was confident she could do. This provided income while she was looking for something better.

Ivette really wanted to go after a job with a specific local resort. The coordinator helped her with the application process, and she was offered an interview. Ivette was coached on the importance of dressing to impress and how to have a successful remote interview. Ivette completed the remote interview and was offered a full-time position as a Public Area Attendant. She maintained the part-time dishwashing job through the entire interview process with the resort, which was a victory for her, and now has the job she wanted.

Ivette is extremely excited!

## **ACCESS Training**


