We are thrilled to share that our Disability Services Manager, Pauline, and our Director, Jessica, were honored at the May Annual Dinner for the Junior League of Southwest Florida. Their dedication and hard work is making a significant impact on our community.



Golisano Imagine the possibilities!

The Golisano Foundation awarded Goodwill SWFL a \$45,000 grant to formalize the Disability Navigation Program. Goodwill looks for gaps in available services and meets those needs to help people in Southwest Florida move forward. Disability Navigation grew out of a realized gap in services while helping young adults with disabilities as they aged out of the school system.

Jessica Tursi, Director of Disability Services, has assisted 158 families with Disability Navigation this year so far.





Several of our Community Resource Centers offer free English as a Second Language (ESL) classes to help people in the community open doors for a better future. We hosted a graduation ceremony on Friday, May 31st, at our Lehigh CRC to celebrate the acheivements of those who completed the course in Lehigh Acres.

Assisting the community with VITA

The United Way of Lee, Hendry, and Glades Volunteer Income Tax Assistance program, which included 234 volunteers, completed more than 8,100 tax returns this tax season, resulting in \$8.4 million in refunds for Southwest Florida residents.

The collaborative effort of certified VITA volunteers, who assist households earning \$66,000 or less by preparing and e-filing their federal tax returns free of charge, and community partners enabled the operation of 23 traditional tax sites and 15 special events across a five-county area in Southwest Florida. Volunteers provided 18,000 hours of service, valued at an estimated \$572,400, with VITA's total community impact reaching \$11.5 million.



Giancarlos Castano, Goodwill's Mobile Community Resource Coordinator and VITA volunteer, assisted 282 individuals this tax season with their tax return, and Lourdes Forste, Goodwill's GIVE coordinator, reviewed them.

Gov. Ron DeSantis held a press conference at the Home Depot in Fort Myers on June 4th. The Governor stressed the importance of being prepared for hurricane season as we start the season, and the Disaster Preparedness Sales Tax Holiday which is currently underway in Florida.

Goodwill carries several disaster prepareness supplies. We have about 28 generators out in the larger stores, batteries, lighters, candles, and mini flashlights that are 2 for \$3.






Summer Life Skills Series
