Marlene's greatest accomplishments so far include getting started on up-skilling in technology and English and landing a job at one of the Goodwill retail stores.


It has been a good experience for her to get connected to her community after a year in the US with very few English skills and in relative isolation.

Advocacy Update - We're thrilled to share that Senate Bill 1758, aimed at improving care navigation services, has passed! Pathways to Opportunity had the incredible opportunity to have representatives present during this pivotal moment, advocating for the needs and rights of individuals with disabilities and their families.

This groundbreaking legislation will: Require the Agency for Persons with Disabilities (APD) to provide care navigation services.

Align care plans with Individual Education Plans (IEPs) for students with disabilities.

Introduce online APD service applications for better access. Create a comprehensive transition waiver for clients entering adulthood.

Reduce crisis response time from 45 to 15 days. Lower the aging caregiver threshold from 70 to 60.

This is a significant step toward a more inclusive, supportive environment. Thanks to Senate President Kathleen Passidomo and all involved □
