#### **New West Cape United Way Resiliency Hub**

On April 29th, we celebrated the ribbon-cutting for the new Cape Coral United Way Resiliency Hub at our West Cape Goodwill (1499 SW Pine Island Road in Cape Coral). The new Resiliency Hub will be co-located with the Goodwill Community Resource Center (CRC). Angela Hemstreet, Goodwill SWFL's Director of Employment Services explains, "In March, Goodwill was invited for this CRC location to become a Resiliency Hub, and we are happy to have it added to the local directory of UW Resiliency Hubs."

UW Resiliency Hubs serve as a one-stop-shop where individuals and families can receive wraparound social services from multiple community organizations. They have provided 524,000 services in Lee, Hendry and Glades counties, and in times of disaster, serve as distribution sites for tarps, water and other emergency needs. Additional social service agencies are also expected to take up residence at the new location.

When Alejandro arrived at Goodwill's Lehigh Community Resource Center, he was overwhelmed by the digital job search process. New to the U.S. and unfamiliar with technology, he struggled with resumes and online applications. That changed after he attended Goodwill's Employability Workshop, where he learned how to build a professional resume, navigate job search websites, and practice interview skills.

With guidance from Coordinator, Sheila, Alejandro created a strong resume and applied to Goodwill —he got the job! He continued visiting the center to learn to use tools like Microsoft Teams and to complete HR paperwork, gaining both skills and confidence with each visit.

Alejandro shared with the coordinator how grateful he was for the support he received, and how he's now sharing with others that Goodwill can offer this same support and guidance in their skilling and employment journeys!
