The SWFL MicroEnterprise Institute is a small business program offered by Goodwill Industries of Southwest Florida that provides aspiring small business owners with the skills they need to succeed as entrepreneurs and become more independent.

Since its inception, the program has graduated 1140 individuals, and assisted in starting/strengthening 660 businesses, giving employment opportunity for additional 55

individuals. To date over 70% are still in operation.




